Under the authority of section 155 of the Forestry Act and the Subordinate Legislation Revision and Consolidation Act , the Lieutenant-Governor in Council makes the following regulations.

Short title

1. These regulations may be cited as the Forest Fire Offence and Penalty Regulations .

Offence

2. A person who

(a) contravenes the Forest Fire Regulations ; or

(b) fails to comply with a permit or a condition of a permit issued under the Forestry Act or the Forest Fire Regulations ;

is guilty of an offence and liable

(c) where the complaint is laid and summons issued by means of a ticket

(i) for a first offence, to a fine of \$75 or in default of payment, imprisonment for 3 days;  
and

(ii) for a subsequent offence, to a fine of \$150 or in default of payment, imprisonment for 6 days; or

(d) where the complaint is laid and summons issued by means other than a ticket

(i) for a first offence, to a fine not less than \$500 or in default of payment to imprisonment for not longer than 3 months; and

(ii) for a subsequent offence, to a fine not less than \$1,000 or in default of payment to imprisonment for not longer than 3 months.
