## 7. Repeal

### Short title

1. These regulations may be cited as the Chicken Farmers of Newfoundland and Labrador Licensing Regulations .

### Prohibition

2. A person shall not engage in the marketing of chicken in the province unless he or she is the holder of a valid licence issued by the board and pays to the board annually the fee prescribed by the minister.

### Monthly report

3. A licensee shall report on a monthly basis to the board the total number of kilograms of chicken which was marketed by him or her in the previous month.

### Expiry

4. A licence shall expire on December 31 of the year for which it was issued.

### Compliance required

5. The licensee shall comply with all orders and regulations of the board.

### Refusal of licence

6. The board may refuse to issue or renew a licence or suspend or revoke a licence where the applicant or licensee has failed to observe, perform or carry out a condition of the licence.
