

Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Regulation 2001

As at 1 September 2001

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1982* . Minister for Mineral Resources

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remake, with no changes in substance, the provisions of the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) (Fees) Regulation 1996* . That Regulation will be repealed on 1 September 2001 under section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989* . The new Regulation prescribes the amounts of fees for the purposes of the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1982* . This Regulation is made under the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1982* and, in particular, under section 152 (the general regulation-making power) and the other sections referred to in the Regulation. This Regulation comprises or relates to matters arising under legislation that is substantially uniform or complementary with legislation of the Commonwealth or another State or Territory.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Regulation 2001* .

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 September 2001.

Note: This Regulation replaces the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) (Fees) Regulation 1996* which is repealed on 1 September 2001 under section 10 (2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989* .

3 Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1982* .

4 Notes

The explanatory note, table of contents and notes in the text of this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

5 Fees

The prescribed fee for the purposes of a provision of the Act specified in Schedule 1 is the fee specified opposite that provision.

6 Saving

Any act, matter or thing that had effect under the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) (Fees) Regulation 1996* immediately before the repeal of that Regulation is taken to have effect under this Regulation.
