1994a, and makes the annexed Order Respecting the Withdrawal from Disposal of

Certain Lands in the Northwest Territories.

ORDER RESPECTING THE WITHDRAWAL FROM DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN LANDS IN THE NORTHWEST

TERRITORIES

SHORT TITLE

1. This Order may be cited as the Withdrawal from Disposal Order Aulavik (Banks

Island) National Park, Northwest Territories.

PURPOSE

2. The purpose of this Order is to withdraw certain lands from disposal to

establish the Aulavik (Banks Island) National Park.

LANDS WITHDRAWN FROM DISPOSAL

3. Subject to section 4, the lands described in the schedule are withdrawn from

disposal for the period beginning on the date of registration and ending on June

1, 2002.

EXCEPTIONS

4. Section 3 does not apply in respect of

(a) existing located or recorded mineral claims or prospecting permits in good

standing acquired under the Canada Mining Regulations;

(b) existing rights in good standing created pursuant to section 8 of the Territorial Lands Act or under the Territorial Lands Regulations;

(c) rights to obtain surface leases on existing or located or recorded mineral

claims acquired pursuant to section 8 of the Territorial Lands Act or under the

Territorial Lands Regulations;

(d) existing permits, special renewal permits and leases in good standing acquired under the Canada Oil and Gas Land Regulations;

(e) existing permits in good standing acquired under the Territorial Quarrying

Regulations;

(f) existing rights, permits and interests granted under the Canada Petroleum

Resources Act;

(g) existing rights issued pursuant to the Territorial Coal Regulations or the

Territorial Dredging Regulations or pursuant to the Forest Management Act of the

Northwest Territories; and

(h) interests in lands described in Exhibit 2 of the Acquisition Agreement,

dated May 5, 1988, among Her Majesty in right of Canada, the Northern Canada

Power Commission, the Government of the Northwest Territories and the Northwest

Power Corporation.

SCHEDULE

(Sections 3 and 4)

LANDS WITHDRAWN FROM DISPOSAL

In the Northwest Territories;

on Banks Island;

All that parcel being more particularly described as follows:

All topographic features hereinafter referred to being according to the First

Edition of the Cape M'Clure map sheet, and the Second Edition of the Mercy Bay,

White Sand Creek, Deans Dundas Bay, Jesse Harbour and Bernard River map sheets,

98E, 88F, 88C, 88B, 98A and 98D and C of the National Topographic System, produced at a scale of 1:250,000 by the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources at Ottawa (map sheets 98E, 88B and 88C being produced by the Army

Survey Establishment, R.C.E.). All coordinates are derived from the above mentioned map sheet series being referred to the 1927 Datum.

Commencing at a point on the ordinary low water mark of M'Clure Strait at the

mouth of an unnamed creek at approximate latitude $74^{\circ}16'37''$ north and approximate longitude $117^{\circ}58'44''$ west;

thence southeasterly in a straight line an approximate distance of 28 kilometres

to a point at latitude $74^{\circ}02'51''$ north and longitude $117^{\circ}38'20''$ west;

thence southerly in a straight line an approximate distance of 24 kilometres to

a point at latitude $73^{\circ}50'00''$ north and longitude $117^{\circ}38'00''$ west;

thence west in a straight line an approximate distance of 11 kilometres to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}50'00''$ north and longitude $118^{\circ}00'00''$ west;

thence south in a straight line an approximate distance of 48 kilometres
to a

point of latitude $73^{\circ}24'00''$ north and longitude $118^{\circ}00'00''$ west;

thence southwesterly in a straight line an approximate distance of 23
kilometres

to a point at latitude $73^{\circ}16'00''$ north and longitude $118^{\circ}32'00''$ west;

thence west in a straight line an approximate distance of 21 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}16'00''$ north and longitude $119^{\circ}12'00''$ west;

thence south in a straight line an approximate distance of 35 kilometres
to a

point of latitude $72^{\circ}57'00''$ north and longitude $119^{\circ}12'00''$ west;

thence west in a straight line an approximate distance of 32 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $72^{\circ}57'00''$ north and longitude $120^{\circ}10'00''$ west;

thence north in a straight line an approximate distance of 47 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}22'00''$ north and longitude $120^{\circ}10'00''$ west;

thence northwesterly in a straight line an approximate distance of 30
kilometres

to a point of latitude $73^{\circ}30'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}00'00''$ west;

thence north in a straight line an approximate distance of 6 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}33'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}00'00''$ west;

thence west in a straight line an approximate distance of 8 kilometres to
a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}33'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}15'00''$ west;

thence north in a straight line an approximate distance of 4 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}35'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}15'00''$ west;

thence west in a straight line an approximate distance of 10 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}35'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}35'00''$ west;

thence north in a straight line an approximate distance of 13 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}42'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}35'00''$ west;

thence east in a straight line an approximate distance of 11 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $73^{\circ}42'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}14'00''$ west;

thence north in a straight line an approximate distance of 86 kilometres
to a

point at latitude $74^{\circ}28'00''$ north and longitude $121^{\circ}14'00''$ west;

thence northeasterly in a straight line an approximate distance of 6
kilometres

to the point of intersection of the ordinary low water mark on the south
side of

M'Clure Strait with latitude $74^{\circ}29'00''$ north at approximate longitude
 $121^{\circ}02'56''$

west;

thence southeasterly following the ordinary low water mark of the south side of

M'Clure Strait to the western end of the sand or gravel bar located at the mouth

of Castel Bay, at approximate latitude 74°14'29" north approximate longitude

119°40'00" west;

thence easterly along the northerly side of said sand or gravel bar extending

across the mouth of Castel Bay and the ordinary low water mark of M'Clure Strait

to the most northerly tip of Mahogany Point;

thence easterly, southerly, easterly, northerly and northeasterly following the

ordinary low water mark of the south side of M'Clure Strait and the westerly,

southerly and easterly sides of Mercy Bay and the said south side of M'Clure

Strait to a point of commencement.

Containing approximately 12,200 square kilometres.

Including all mines and minerals, including hydrocarbons, whether solid, liquid

or gaseous, and rights to work the same;

Saving and excepting therefrom and reserving thereout construction material that

may disposed of pursuant to the Territorial Quarrying Regulations; and

Saving and excepting therefrom and reserving thereout timber that may disposed

of pursuant to the Forest Management Act of the Northwest Territories.

Saving and excepting therefrom and reserving thereout Reserve number 88F/4-1-2

in the name of the Resources, Wildlife and Economic Development, Government of

the Northwest Territories, as shown in the record of the Land Administration in

Yellowknife under file number 88F/4-1.
