Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Fisheries (Challenger Area Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2010.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 16 December 2010.
- 3 Principal regulations amended**
These regulations amend the Fisheries (Challenger Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986.
- 4 Offences and penalties**
Regulation 5(1) is amended by inserting “3C,” after “3B.”

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 16 December 2010, amend regulation 5(1) of the Fisheries (Challenger Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986. Regulation 5(1) specifies the regulations the breach of which carries a maximum penalty of \$10,000. The amendment inserts a reference to regulation 3C, which relates to taking or possessing a sand flounder less than 25 cm in length in the Challenger Fisheries Management Area.
