Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Fisheries (Reporting) Amendment Regulations 2012.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 3 January 2013.
- 3 Principal regulations**
These regulations amend the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2001 (the **principal regulations**).
- 4 Schedule 3 amended**
In Schedule 3, Part 2C, insert the item set out in the Schedule of these regulations.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 3 January 2013, amend Schedule 3 of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2001 (the **principal regulations**).

The amendment inserts a reference to oceanic whitetip shark into Part 2C of Schedule 3 of the principal regulations. Part 2C speci-

fies protected fish species. As a consequence of the amendment, a permit holder (as defined in the principal regulations) who takes any oceanic whitetip shark must complete a protected species catch return in accordance with regulation 11E of the principal regulations.
