The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1. Title

(1) This Act is the Animal Welfare Amendment Act 2000.

(2) In this Act, the Animal Welfare Act 1999 is called "the principal Act".

2. Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3. Interpretation

Section 2(1) of the principal Act is amended by inserting in paragraph (a) of the definition of the term trap, after the word "mechanical", the words "or adhesive".
