An Act to amend the Agricultural Pests Destruction Act 1967

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title---This Act may be cited as the Agricultural Pests Destruction Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Pests Destruction Act 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Agricultural Pests Destruction Council---Section 4 (2) (a) of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subparagraph (iii), and substituting the following subparagraph:

"(iii) One on the nomination of the New Zealand Local Government Association Incorporated:".

3. Transitional provisions---(1) Notwithstanding any- thing in section 2 of this Act, the person (if any) who, immediately before the commencement of this section, held office as a member of the Council pursuant to section 4 (2) (a) (iii) of the principal Act shall, unless that person sooner dies or vacates office under section 7 of the principal Act, continue to hold that office until the expiry of the term for which that person was appointed, and shall be eligible for reappointment.

(2) For the purposes of section 10 (9) of the principal Act, the person to whom subsection (1) of this section applies shall, after the commencement of this section, be deemed to have been appointed to the Council on the nomination of the New Zealand Local Government Association Incorporated.

(3) Any person who, immediately before the commencement of this section, held office pursuant to section 10 (8) of the principal Act as the deputy of the person to whom subsection (1) of this section applies shall continue to hold that office as if section 2 of this Act had not been passed.
