

# ANTARCTIC MARINE LIVING RESOURCES AMENDMENT ACT 2001

### Legislative history

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

#### 1. Title—

(1) This Act is the Antarctic Marine Living Resources Amendment Act 2001.

(2) In this Act, the Antarctic Marine Living Resources Act 1981 is called "the principal Act".

#### 2. Commencement—

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

#### 3. Offence to take marine organism without permit—

Section 7(1) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the expression "\$10,000", and substituting the expression "\$250,000".

#### 4. Offences and penalties—

Section 13 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (3)(a) the expression "\$5,000", and substituting the expression "\$100,000":

(b)by omitting from subsection (3)(b) the expression ``\$1,000", and substituting the expression ``\$100,000".
