Legislative history

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

.Commencement—

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

.Existing national parks—

Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by adding the following subsection:

“(4)By virtue of Order in Council dated 3 April 2000 (Gazette 1 June 2000, p 1281), Urewera National Park is now called Te Urewera National Park.”
