

MEAT (GAME AND STOCK) ORDER 1998

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Meat Act 1981, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ANALYSIS

1. Title and commencement
2. Wallabies declared to be game
3. Certain animals declared to be stock
4. Revocation

ORDER

1. Title and commencement---(1) This order may be cited as the Meat (Game and Stock) Order 1998.

(2) This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. Wallabies declared to be game---Wallabies are game for the purposes of the Meat Act 1981.

3. Certain animals declared to be stock---The following animals are stock for the purposes of the Meat Act 1981:

- (a) Alpacas, asses, bison (other than those animals of the species *Bison bison athabasca*), donkeys, llamas, and water-buffaloes (other than those animals of the species *Bubalis arnee*);
- (b) Any animals (being animals that are herded, mustered, or handled, in the manner of farm animals or are kept within an effective fence or enclosure for farming purposes) that are hybrids of an animal that is stock and any other animal.

4. Revocation---The Meat (Stock) Order 1991

is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force 28 days after notification in the Gazette, applies to wallabies the provisions of the Meat Act 1981 relating to game, and to hybrids (such as beefaloes) of stock and other animals the provisions of that Act relating to stock. The Meat (Stock) Order 1991 is revoked and the animals listed in that order (other than 2 hybrids that are now included in the general description) are included in this order.
