Pursuant to sections 186 and 297 of the Fisheries Act 1996, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Regulations

1 Title

(1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Kaimoana Customary Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2001.

(2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Kaimoana Customary Fishing) Regulations 1998 SR 1998/434 are called "the principal regulations".

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 October 2001.

3 New regulation 46 substituted

The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulation 46, and substituting the following regulation:

"46 Penalties

A person who commits an offence against these regulations is liable as follows:

"(a) on the first occasion on which the person is convicted of 1 or more offences, the person is liable in respect of that offence or each of those offences (as the case may be) to a fine not exceeding \$10,000:

"(b) on every subsequent occasion on which the person is convicted of 1 or more offences, the person is liable in respect of that offence or each of those offences (as the case may be) to a fine not exceeding \$20,000."
