PURSUANT to the Plants Act 1970, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Commencement---These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
2. Regulations revoked---The Potato Cyst Nematode Regulations 1974 are hereby revoked.
3. Director-General may revoke declarations---The Director-General may revoke any declaration under regulation 3 of the said regulations, notwithstanding that the potato cyst nematode may be able to be found---
 - (a) On the land to which it relates; or
 - (b) On land within 80 kilometres of it.
