Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2007.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 15 November 2007.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986.

4 Trawling prohibited in certain seamount areas

(1) Regulation 15JA(2) is amended by revoking paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:

"(c) the area located in fisheries management area 6 that is bounded by---

"(i) the latitudes 50°30'S and 51°25'S; and

"(ii) the longitudes 163°35'E and 165°00'E".

(2) Regulation 15JA(2)(d) is revoked.
