Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Fisheries (Satellite Vessel Monitoring) Amendment Regulations 2007.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 15 November 2007.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Satellite Vessel Monitoring) Regulations 1993.

4 Interpretation

Regulation 2 is amended by inserting the following definition in its appropriate alphabetical order:

"benthic protection area has the meaning given to it in regulation 4 of the Fisheries (Benthic Protection Areas) Regulations 2007".

5 Vessels required to carry and operate automatic location communicators
Regulation 3(1) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (ea):

"(eb) New Zealand fishing vessels of 28 metres or less in length that are used at any time during a fishing year to trawl within a benthic protection

area; and".
