Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Dairy Industry (Fees) Regulations 2000.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

3 Fees

(1) The fees set out in the Schedule are payable in respect of the matters to which they relate.

(2) The fees set out are inclusive of goods and services tax.

4 Revocation

The Dairy Industry (Fees) Regulations 1990 (SR 1990/289) are revoked.
