Regulations

- 1 Title
 - These regulations are the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2008.
- 2 Commencement
 - These regulations come into force on 1 April 2008.
- 3 Principal regulations amended
 - These regulations amend the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986.
- 4 New regulation 8 substituted
 - Regulation 8 is revoked and the following regulation substituted:
 - “8 Seasonal restrictions on taking scallop
 - Despite regulation 24 of the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, no person may take scallop, or possess scallop taken, from the Auckland Fishery Management Area (East) or the Auckland Fishery Management Area (West) between 1 April and 31 August in the same year (both days inclusive).”
