

Horticultural Prescribed Products (Boysenberries) Order 1990
(SR 1990/18)

Note

This order is administered in the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.

PURSUANT to section 24 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and the Minister of Overseas Trade and Marketing made in compliance with section 25 of that Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Boysenberries) Order 1990.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2 Interpretation

- In this order—
The Act means the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987
Boysenberries means the product specified in clause 3 of this order.

3 Boysenberries declared to be prescribed product

- The following product is hereby declared to be a prescribed product for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987:
Boysenberries, fruit of *Rubus* hybrid Boysen.

Clause 3 was amended, as from 10 November 2000, by clause 3 Horticultural Prescribed Products (Boysenberries) Amendment Order 2000 (SR 2000/231), by substituting the item “Boysenberry, fruit of *Rubus* hybrid Boysen” for the item “Boysenberries (*Rubus* hybrid Boysen)”.

4 Boysenberries to be subject to export licensing

- Boysenberries are hereby declared to be subject to export licensing in accordance with Part 3 of the Act on and from the 1st day of July 1990.

5 Recognised product group

- The body that, on the commencement of the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Boysenberries) Order 1990, Amendment No 1, was known as New Zealand Boysenberry Council Limited is hereby declared to be the product group recognised under section 25 of the Act as suitable to carry out the functions of a recognised product group in relation to boysenberries.

Regulation 5 was amended by regulation 2 Horticultural Prescribed Products (Boysenberries) Order 1990, Amendment No 1 (SR 1993/247) by substituting the words “The body that, on the commencement of the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Boysenberries) Order 1990, Amendment No. 1, was known as New Zealand Boysenberry Council” for the words “Berryfruit Export (NZ)”.
