

**Horticultural Prescribed Products ([Buttercup] Squash) Order 1988**  
(SR 1988/252)

**Note**

This order is administered in the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.

PURSUANT to section 24 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and the Minister of Overseas Trade and Marketing made in compliance with section 25 of that Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Buttercup Squash) Order 1988.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

Regulation 1(1) was amended by regulation 2(2) Horticultural Prescribed Products (Buttercup Squash) Order 1988, Amendment No 1 (SR 1991/93) by inserting the word “Buttercup” before the word “Squash”.

2 Interpretation

- In this order,—  
**The Act** means the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987  
**Buttercup squash** means the product specified in clause 3 of this order.  
Regulation 2 was amended by regulation 2(3) Horticultural Prescribed Products (Buttercup Squash) Order 1988, Amendment No 1 (SR 1991/93) by substituting the definition of “Buttercup Squash” for the definition of “Squash”.

3 Buttercup squash declared to be a prescribed product

- The following product is hereby declared to be a prescribed product for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987:

fruit (being only the fruit commonly known as buttercup squash) of plants of the species *Cucurbita maxima*.

Regulation 3 was amended by regulations 2(4) Horticultural Prescribed Products (Buttercup Squash) Order 1988, Amendment No 1 (SR 1991/93) by substituting the item "fruit (being only . . .species *Cucurbita maxima*" for the item "Squash (*cucurbita maxima*)".

#### 4 Buttercup squash to be subject to export licensing

- Buttercup squash are hereby declared to be subject to export licensing in accordance with Part 3 of the Act.

Regulation 4 was substituted by regulation 3 Horticultural Prescribed Products (Buttercup Squash) Order 1988, Amendment No 1 (SR 1991/93).

#### 5 Recognised product group

- The body that was, on the commencement of the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Buttercup Squash) Order 1988, Amendment No 1, known as the New Zealand Buttercup Squash Council Incorporated is hereby declared to be the product group recognised under section 25 of the Act as suitable to carry out the functions of a recognised product group in relation to buttercup squash.

Regulation 5 was substituted by regulation 3 Horticultural Prescribed Products (Buttercup Squash) Order 1988, Amendment No 1 (SR 1991/93).
