

**New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Kiwifruit for Export to Australia) Order 2003**

1 Title

- This order is the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Kiwifruit for Export to Australia) Order 2003.

2 Commencement

- This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

3 Kiwifruit defined

- In this order, **kiwifruit** means the fruit of a plant of the genus Actinidia.

4 Kiwifruit exported for consumption in Australia declared prescribed product

- Kiwifruit exported to Australia for consumption in Australia are declared to be a prescribed product for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987.

5 Kiwifruit exported for consumption in Australia subject to export licensing

- Kiwifruit exported to Australia for consumption in Australia are subject to export licensing in accordance with Part 3 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987.

6 Product group recognised for kiwifruit exported for consumption in Australia

- The body that was known, immediately before the commencement of this order, as New Zealand Kiwifruit Product Group to Australia Incorporated is recognised as the product group for kiwifruit exported to Australia for consumption in Australia.
