1 Title

- This order is the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Truffles) Order 2002.

2 Commencement

- This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

4 Truffles declared prescribed product

- Truffles are declared to be a prescribed product for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987.

5 Truffles subject to export licensing

- Truffles are subject to export licensing in accordance with Part 3 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987.

6 Product group recognised for truffles

- The body that was known as Southern Truffles New Zealand Limited immediately before the commencement of this order is recognised as the product group for truffles.
