Pursuant to sections 81D and 81H of the Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines Act 1997, Her Excellency the Administrator of the Government acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Minister for Food Safety, makes the following regulations.

- 4A Director-General may grant exemption, waiver, or refund

Regulations

- 1 Title
 - These regulations are the Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines (Fees and Charges) Amendment Regulations 2009.
- 2 Commencement
 - These regulations come into force on 1 July 2009.
- 3 Principal regulations amended
 - These regulations amend the Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines (Fees and Charges) Regulations 2002.
- 4 Interpretation
 - Regulation 3 is amended by inserting the following definition in its appropriate alphabetical order:
“*Director-General* has the same meaning as in the Act”.
- 5 New regulation 4A inserted
 - The following regulation is inserted after regulation 4:
“4A Director-General may grant exemption, waiver, or refund
 - The Director-General may grant an exemption from, or waive or refund, any fee or charge specified in these regulations, in whole or in part, in any particular case or class of cases.”
