

Marine Reserve (Long Bay-Okura) Order 1995

PURSUANT to section 4(1) of the Marine Reserves Act 1971, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Conservation made under section 5(9) of that Act (a recommendation with which the Minister of Transport and the Minister of Fisheries concur) and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Marine Reserve (Long Bay-Okura) Order 1995.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2 Long Bay-Okura, Auckland Marine Reserve constituted

- The area described in the Schedule to this order is hereby declared to be a marine reserve to be known as the Long Bay-Okura Marine Reserve.

Long Bay-Okura marine reserve

All that area comprising 980 hectares, more or less, situated in the North Auckland Land District, in and adjoining North Shore City and Rodney District, being Part Bed of the Sea, situated in Blocks XII, XV, and XVI, Waiwera Survey District, shown marked "A" on SO Plan 68050, lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor for the North Auckland Land District.
