

Marine Reserve (Te Tapuwae O Rongokako) Order 1999

PURSUANT to section 4(1) of the Marine Reserves Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Conservation made under section 5(9) of that Act (a recommendation with which the Minister of Transport and the Minister for Food, Fibre, Biosecurity and Border Control concur), and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Marine Reserve (Te Tapuwae o Rongokako) Order 1999.
- (2) This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2 Te Tapuwae o Rongokako Marine Reserve constituted

- The area described in the Schedule is declared to be a marine reserve to be known as the Te Tapuwae o Rongokako Marine Reserve.

Schedule

Te Tapuwae o Rongokako Marine Reserve

All that area comprising 2452 hectares, more or less, being Part bed of South Pacific Ocean approximately adjacent to an area of coast between the Pouawa River and the Waiomoko River, shown marked A on SO Plan 8918 lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor for the Gisborne Land District, and including the foreshore and the waters that at any material time are upon or vertically above that area.
