Marine Reserve (Kermadec Islands) Order 1990
(SR 1990/305)

Note

This order is administered in the Department of Conservation.

PURSUANT to section 4(1) of the Marine Reserves Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Conservation made under section 5(9) of that Act with the concurrence of the Minister of Fisheries and the Minister of Transport, and by and with the consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

1 Title and commencement

- (1) This order may be cited as the Marine Reserve (Kermadec Islands) Order 1990.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2 Marine reserve constituted

- The area described in the Schedule to this order is hereby declared to be a marine reserve.

Schedule

Clause 2

Description of the reserve

- 224 000 hectares, more or less, being part sea bed surrounding Raoul and adjacent islands of the Kermadec Islands, at approximate latitude 29°15' south, longitude 177°55' west; being more particularly shown marked A on SO plan 65753 lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor for the North Auckland Land District.
- 320 000 hectares, more or less, being part sea bed surrounding Macauley, Curtis, and adjacent islands of the Kermadec Islands, at approximate latitude 30°25' south, longitude 178°30' west; being more particularly shown marked B on SO plan 65753 so lodged.
- 204 000 hectares, more or less, being part sea bed surrounding L'Esperance and Harve Rocks of the Kermadec Islands, at approximate latitude 31°20' south, longitude 178°50' west; being more particularly shown marked C on SO plan 65753 so lodged.
- The Schedule was amended by regulation 2 Marine Reserve (Kermadec Islands) Order 1990, Amendment No 1 (SR 1991/98) by substituting the expressions as follows:—
 - In item 1; “224 000” for “221 800”, “29°15” for “29°30”, “177°55” for “178°00”.
 - In item 2; “320 000” for “321 400”, “30°25” for “30°30”.

- In item 3; “204 000” for “192 400”, “31°20” for “31°30”, “178°50” for “179°00”.
