### **Regulations**

- 1 Title**  
These regulations are the Biosecurity (Forms) Amendment Regulations 2010.

**2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 22 April 2010.

**3 Principal regulations amended**

These regulations amend the Biosecurity (Forms) Regulations 1995.

**4 Certain forms prescribed**

Regulation 3(c) and (e) are revoked.

**5 Forms C and E of Schedule revoked**

Forms C and E of the Schedule are revoked.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 22 April 2010, amend the Biosecurity (Forms) Regulations 1995 by revoking forms C and E from the Schedule. Forms C and E are forms of infringement notice. New regulations providing for infringement offences will provide for the appropriate forms (*see* the Biosecurity (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2010).
