SIND LIVESTOCK IMPROVEMENT (AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 1984

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933

[Gazette of Sind, Extraordinary, Part I, 12th December, 1984]

No. S. Legis. 1(63)/84.—The following Ordinance by the Governor of Sind is hereby published for general information :—

Preamble.—Whereas the Federal *Shariat* Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933 ;

And whereas it is expedient to amend the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933, in the manner hereinafter appearing ;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of

July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Livestock Improvement (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of section 7 of Sind Act XXII of 1933.*—In the Sind Livestock Improvement Act, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 7, in subsection (5), the full-stop appearing at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added :—

“Provided that no order of refusal to grant or revocation of a licence shall be passed unless the applicant for the licence or, as the case may be, the person keeping the bull is given an opportunity of being heard.”

3. *Amendment of section 22 of Sind Act XXII of 1933.*—In the said Act, in section 22, the full-stop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added :—

“Provided that no order or proceedings shall be modified, annulled or reversed, unless the person affected is given an opportunity of being heard.”
