1 regulations may contain the subject matter appearing in KSPL No.
2 K6113-2000, as amended by KSPL No. K6-126-2001. The
3 comprehensive rules and regulations may also regulate the
4 following matters and subjects: any matter that is the subject of
5 existing Koror State law pertaining directly or indirectly to the
6 environment; any matter relating to the exploration and exploitation of
7 all living and non-living resources of the State, including the
8 regulation of research and studies conducted for commercial,
9 educational, scientific, or other purposes; regulating any conduct or
10 activity, including regulating use of designated areas and charging or
11 amending fees for rock island uses and activities; regulating the
12 conservation and management of flora, fauna, rock islands, reefs,
13 beaches, marine and land resources, marine and terrestrial materials,
14 and all living and non-living resources owned by the State of Koror.
15 The rules and regulations shall comply with 40 PNC 2102(c) for the
16 imposition of any new fees or charges.”

17 **SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction
18 determines that any part or portion of any portion of this law is invalid, then the offending portion or
19 portions may be stricken, and the remaining portions shall continue in full force and effect.

20 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act shall become effective upon its becoming
21 law by operation of the Koror State Constitution.
