SUBJECT: Establishing a fish sanctuary in Laguna de Bay to be known as the Laguna de Bay Fish Sanctuary

Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 4326 authorizing the establishment of a fish sanctuary in Laguna de Bay, relation to the provisions of Section 74 of Act No. 4003, as amended, Section 4, paragraph A, subparagraph 2 of Presidential Decree No. 43, the following rules and regulations are hereby promulgated for the information and guidance of all concerned:

SECTION 1. Area. - A fish sanctuary is hereby set aside and established over an area of approximately 5,000 hectares in Laguna de Bay within the body of water formed by imaginary straight lines running from the following points:

From Bay Island bearing Point 1, thence

N 34 - 30 W	8,100 mts. to Point 2
N 46 - 30 E	2,290 mts. to Point 3
N 37 - 00 E	1,295 mts. to Point 4
N 11 - 00 E	2,675 mts. to Point 5
S 81 - 00 E	3,440 mts. to Point 6
S 2° - 30 W	3,490 mts. to Point 7
S 25° - 00 E	1,180 mts. to Point 8
S 18 - 30 W	7,420 mts. to Point 1.

SEC. 2. Administration and control. - The aforementioned fish sanctuary is hereby placed under the administration and control of the Director of Fisheries who shall submit to this Department the implementing rules and regulations which may be necessary to carry into effect the purposes of this Order.

SEC. 3. Prohibition. - It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct any fishing operation or take, catch, destroy or kill any fish in any place within the aforementioned body of water, or in any manner disturb or drive away or take therefrom any fish fry or fish eggs.

SEC. 4. Penal provision. - Any person found violating the provisions of this Order shall, upon conviction be subject to a fine of not more than five thousand pesos (P5,000.00) or imprisonment for a term of not more than five (5) years, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court: Provided, however, That the Director of Fisheries is hereby empowered to impose an administrative fine of not more than one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) and the impounding and confiscation of the fishing boat and all fishing paraphernalia used therein.

SEC. 5. Repealing clause. - All orders and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. Effectivity. - This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette and in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.

SUBJECT: Amending Section 1 of FAC No. 110 re:  
Establishing a fish sanctuary in La-  
guna de Bay to be known as the Laguna  
de Bay Fish Sanctuary

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Fisheries Administrative Order No. 110 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Area. - A fish sanctuary is hereby set aside and established over an area of approximately 5,000 hectares in Laguna de Bay within the body of water formed by imaginary straight lines running from the following points:

Beginning at a point marked "1" being Bay Island,

Thence N 34° 30' W	-	8,100 M. to Point 2;
Thence N 46° 30' E	-	2,290 M. to Point 3;
Thence N 37° 00' E	-	1,395 M. to Point 4;
Thence N 11° 00' E	-	2,675 M. to Point 5;
Thence S 81° 00' E	-	3,440 M. to Point 6;
Thence S 2° 30' W	-	3,490 M. to Point 7;
Thence S 25° 00' E	-	1,180 M. to Point 8;
Thence S 18° 18' W	-	7,420 M. to Point 1.

SECTION 2. Effectivity. - This administrative order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette and in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
