FISHERIES (BHC) DISEASE DECLARATION 2002

1 Short title

This declaration may be cited as the *Fisheries (BHC) Disease Declaration 2002*.

2 Disease declaration—Act, s 94

(1) A residue of BHC that has a concentration greater than 0.01 mg/kg for the residue in fisheries resources is declared to be a declared disease for the Act.

(2) In this section—

“**BHC**” means a chemical that is the sum of isomers of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6-hexachlorocyclohexane, other than lindane.
