

**EXPROPRIATION AMENDMENT ACT
NO. 19 OF 1977**

[ASSENTED TO 8 MARCH, 1977]

[DATE OF COMMENCEMENT: 1 JANUARY, 1977]

ACT

To amend the Expropriation Act, 1975, so as to further define the expression "Minister" in section 16 (4); to regulate the application of the said Act in relation to the expropriation of property by a provincial administration or a local authority for the construction of a public road; and to provide for incidental matters.

1. Amends section 5 of the Expropriation Act, No. 63 of 1975, by substituting subsection (1).
 2. Amends section 16 of the Expropriation Act, No. 63 of 1975, by substituting subsection (4).
 3. Amends section 26 of the Expropriation Act, No. 63 of 1975, by substituting subsection (2).
 4. **Short title and commencement.**—This Act shall be called the Expropriation Amendment Act, 1977, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 1977.
