

## SECTION 22

### **ANIMALS (DISEASES AND IMPORTS) (CONTROL OF NEWCASTLE DISEASE) REGULATIONS**

*[21<sup>st</sup> September 1964]*

**1.** These regulations may be cited as the Animals (Diseases and Imports)(Control of Newcastle Disease) Regulations.

**2.** In these regulations –

“infected area” means an area declared an infected for Newcastle Disease under the provisions of section 5 of the Act.

**3.** No poultry shall be moved from or into an infected area without a written permit issued by the Chief Veterinary Officer and when a permit has been issued only in strict compliance with any conditions or limitations imposed under such permit.

**4.** Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of regulation 3 of these regulations or any of the conditions or limitations imposed under a permit issued by the Chief Veterinary Officer in accordance with the said regulation, shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to the penalties prescribed by section 24 of the Act.
