Hawksbill Turtles (Protection) (Amendment)
Regulations, 1978.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Turtles Act, the President hereby makes the following Regulations—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Hawksbill Turtles (Protection) (Amendment) Regulations, 1978. Citation

2. Regulation 3(1) of the Hawksbill Turtles (Protection) Regulations, 1977, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations", is amended by inserting immediately after the word "stuffed", which appears therein, the word "female". Amendment

3. The principal Regulations are amended by inserting immediately after regulation 3 thereof the new regulation and Schedule following—
 - 4.—(1) No person shall catch, kill, harpoon or otherwise take possession of any female Hawksbill Turtle in the areas specified in the Schedule. Insertion

 - (2) Any person who contravenes subregulation (1) shall be guilty of an offence and liable to the penalties provided in section 10(2) of the Act.
