

THE FISHERIES ACT.
(CHAPTER 294).

THE FISHING VESSELS (CONTROL AND LICENSING)
(AMENDMENT) RULES 1983.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Fisheries Act the Minister for National Development hereby makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Fishing Vessels (Control and Licensing) (Amendment) Rules 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1984.

2. Rule 8 of the Fishing Vessels (Control and Licensing) Rules 1969 is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph (5), the following paragraph:

“(6) The fee for the issue of a crew book shall be as set out in the First Schedule.”

3. The First Schedule to the Fishing Vessels (Control and Licensing) Rules 1969 is deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor:

“FIRST SCHEDULE. Rules 5, 8 (6) and 13.

(1) For the licensing of —	
(a) a fishing vessel not mechanically propelled or propelled only by an outboard engine	\$ 30 per annum
(b) a fishing vessel propelled by an inboard engine —	
(i) not exceeding 50 gross metric tonnes	\$ 40 per annum
(ii) exceeding 50 gross metric tonnes but not exceeding 100 gross metric tonnes	\$ 80 per annum
(iii) exceeding 100 gross metric tonnes	\$150 per annum
(2) For a certified copy of the particulars entered in the Register of Licences or of a licence	\$ 10
(3) For a certified copy of a document	\$ 10
(4) For a replacement of a licence	half the amount payable for the licence per annum
(5) For a change of numbers of a fishing vessel	\$ 20
(6) For a crew book	\$ 12
(7) For every person employed on any fishing vessel or engaged in any activity thereon	\$ 5 per annum.”
