In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4(1) of the Protected Areas and Protected Places Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (No. 2) Order 2003 and shall come into operation on 7th March 2003.

**Premises declared to be protected area**

**2.** The area described in the second column of the Schedule is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purposes of the Act, and every person who is in that area shall comply with such directions for regulating his movement and conduct as may be given by an authorised officer.

**CAR PARK C AT JURONG PIER ROAD**

All that area comprised in part of Lot 1008M in Mukim No. 6 (PENG KANG), occupied by "CAR PARK C AT JURONG PIER ROAD" containing an area of about 37,687 square metres and bounded approximately as follows:

Commencing at a point south-west of the aforesaid "CAR PARK C AT JURONG PIER ROAD" which point is 32,756.3 metres North and 14,306.7 metres East of the Singapore Land Authority origin of co-ordinates (30,000 metres North, 30,000 metres East), the boundaries run along successive lines of bearings and distances approximately as follows:


