CHAPTER P-22.1 REG 1
The Prairie and Forest Fires Act, 1982

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Forest Fire Contingency Fund Regulations*.

Escaped fire

2 For the purposes of clause 2(e.1) of *The Prairie and Forest Fires Act*, a fire greater than 100 hectares in area is prescribed as an escaped fire.
