## **CHAPTER G-5.1 REG 146**

### *The Government Organization Act*

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as *The Ministry of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport Regulations, 2007*.

**Ministry continued**

**2** The department of the Government of Saskatchewan called the Department of Culture, Youth and Recreation is continued as the Ministry of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport.

**Objects and purposes**

**3** The objects and purposes of the Ministry of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport are the following:

- (a) to provide the structure wherein and whereby the powers, responsibilities and functions of the Minister of Tourism, Parks, Culture and Sport may be exercised and carried out;
- (b) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan that relate to tourism development and that actively promote tourism investment in Saskatchewan;
- (c) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to:
  - (i) conserving, preserving, managing, protecting and developing Saskatchewan's heritage; and
  - (ii) conserving, preserving, managing, protecting and developing areas of prehistoric, environmental, recreational or archaeological interest or significance;
- (d) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan that support a vibrant and sustainable arts community in Saskatchewan that is recognized and valued throughout Saskatchewan and at the national and international level;
- (e) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to the recognition and appreciation of the diverse cultures and backgrounds of Saskatchewan people and that preserve and enhance Saskatchewan's multicultural composition;

- (f) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to urban parks;
- (g) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to sport and recreation;
- (h) to co-ordinate, develop, promote and implement policies and programs of the Government of Saskatchewan relating to cultural, physical and social development of youth.
