

# *The Honey Regulations (Saskatchewan)*

SCHEDULE

**Title**

**1** These regulations may be cited as the Honey Regulations (Saskatchewan).

**Interpretation**

**2** In these Regulations, the expression:

- (a) **“Beekeeper”** means a person registered or required to be registered under The Apiaries Act, 1973.
- (b) **“Honey”** means honey extracted from the honey comb.
- (c) **“Honey comb”** means a structure of cells for the storage of honey.
- (d) **“Honey house”** means a place or premises used by a beekeeper for handling, storing, extracting or packaging honey.
- (e) **“Farmer’s Marker”** means a place or premises, designed, used or operated to facilitate the sale of agricultural products by the producer directly to a person or persons taking delivery at such place or premises.

**Application**

**3** Subject to exemptions stated in Section 4 these Regulations apply to all honey.

**Exemptions**

**4** The Regulations do not apply to honey that is produced by a beekeeper and offered for sale or sold directly to a person taking delivery at the beekeeper’s residence, honey house or at a Farmer’s Market in containers which:

- (i) bear no grade or class markings;
- (ii) display the name and address of the beekeeper; and
- (iii) show the net weight of the contents.

**Grading, Packing and Marketing Requirements**

**5(1)** All honey that is produced offered for sale or sold in Saskatchewan shall be subject to the Canada Agriculture Products Standards Act, Honey Regulations, made by Order-in-Council P.C. 1967-1779, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as the “Honey Regulations (Canada)”).

**(2)** No person shall pack, ship, transport or offer for shipment or transport, advertise, display, sell or offer for sale within Saskatchewan, any honey except in accordance with the Honey Regulations (Canada).
