

**Decree
of the Ministry of Environment of the Slovak Republic
of 7 April 2000**

on setting up the maximum acceptable values of polluting substances emitted to the air

The Ministry of Environment of the Slovak Republic in accordance with Article 5, paragraph 7 of the Act No 309/1991 Coll. on Air Protection against Polluting Substances /Clean Air Act/, as amended by the Act No 393/1998 Coll. stipulates:

§1

This Decree determines the maximum acceptable values of polluting substances of sulphur oxides expressed as sulphur dioxide that are allowed to be emitted from large polluting sources¹ to the air in the course of a calendar year /hereinafter "emission quota of sulphur dioxide/

§2

/1/ Emission quotas set up for sulphur dioxide are depicted in the Annex.

/2/ Emission quotas of sulphur dioxide shall be stipulated in a decision² which shall be issued for the year

a/ 2002, by 31 March 2001 at the latest,

b/ 2003, by 31 March 2002 at the latest,

c/ 2004, by 31 March 2003 at the latest.

§3

This Decree shall enter into force on 1 May 2000.
