

DOGS AND CATS REGULATIONS – SECTION 11

(Legal Notices 13 of 1994, 15 of 1998 and 12 of 2007)

Short title

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dogs and Cats Regulations.

Dog licences

2. A dog licence must contain—
 - (a) the name and address of the person to whom the licence is issued; and
 - (b) a description of the dog stating in particular whether it is a male or female dog and if it is a female dog whether it is capable of producing progeny; and
 - (c) a licence number; and
 - (d) a condition that the keeper of the dog in respect of which the licence is issued must ensure that the dog at all times wears a collar to which is attached a disc inscribed with the licence number referred to in paragraph (c).

Fees

- 3.⁷ The annual fee for a dog licence is—
