

CROWN LANDS (ALLOTMENT TO LOCAL AUTHORITY) REGULATIONS – SECTION 7

(Statutory Instrument 57/1985)

Commencement [31 August 1985]

1. SHORT TITLE

These Regulations may be cited as the Crown Lands (Allotment to Local Authority) Regulations.

2. ALLOTMENT OF CROWN LANDS

The Cabinet may, by order, allot to a local authority as defined in section 2 of the Local Authorities Act, the administrative control of any lands or interest therein owned by the Crown and thereupon the lands or interest so allotted shall be held and dealt with by the local authority in accordance with the Local Authorities Act.¹
