

*Water and Sewerage Authority (Vesting of Lands) (No. 1) Order***SAINT LUCIA****STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS, 1986, No. 22**

[22nd March, 1986.]

1. Citation. This Order may be cited as the Water and Sewerage Authority, (Vesting of Lands) (No. 1) Order, 1986.

2. Vesting of Lands. The lands described in the Schedule, being lands acquired under the provisions of the Land Acquisition Ordinance, are hereby vested in the Water and Sewerage Authority.

Made by the Governor - General under section 12 (2) of the Water and Sewerage Authority Act, 1984, (No. 18 of 1984) this 17th day of March, 1986.

1. All that piece or parcel of land situate at Grace in the quarter of Vieux-Fort belonging to Heirs Cherie Jn. Charles and bounded as follows:

- NORTH: By Lands said to belong to Heirs Cherie Jn. Charles.

- EAST: By a 20 feet Public Road to Grace.
