AN ORDINANCE to amend the Birds and Fish Protection Ordinance, Cap. 44.

[24th December, 1946.]

Enacted by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of Saint Vincent.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Birds and Fish Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Birds and Fish Protection Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance).

Short title.

Cap. 44.

2. After Section 15 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be inserted:—

New section added to principal Ordinance.

16. The Governor in Council may by proclamation declare any area to be a sanctuary for the birds enumerated in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance and during the continuance in force of such proclamation it shall be an offence against this Ordinance for any person—

Bird sanctuaries.

- (a) to kill or wound any such bird, or to injure or destroy the eggs or nest of any such bird, within such area; or
- (b) to take any such bird or the eggs or nest of any such bird from such area.
