Ngorongoro Conservation Area Ordinance (Cap 413) Read as one with Game Parks Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1975 (Act No. 14 of 1975)

BY-LAWS

(Made under sections 8 and 9)

Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authority (control of settlement, Residence, and prevention of soil erosion, flora and fauna) by-laws, 1992

Title

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authority)(control of settlement, residence, and prevention of soil erosion, flora and fauna) by-laws, 1992.

Interpre tation

2. In these By-laws "Authority means" the Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authority as established under section 4 of the Act.

"The Act" means Game laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1975.

"Conservator means" the Conservator of the Conservation Area appointed in accordance with the provisions of section 58 of the Act;

"Prohibited Area" means any area which under these by-laws may be declared a prohibited area:

"The Board" means the Board of Directors of the Authority;

"Prescribed" means prescribed by the Board or the Conservator;

any word connoting a male gender includes a female gender.

Prohibited

3. The Authority may declare any area a prohibited area.

Prohibited areas not be built dulti-vated etc.

- 4. No person, without the permission of the Board and the consent of the Conservator shall set up a residence or settlement in any part of the Conservation Area, cultivate, graze in a restricted area, cut trees, collect honey or any forest produce whatsoever, clear land or vegetation, firing or destroying vegetation, use weapons, snares, traps, nets or poison and do any other prohibited or restricted act as provided in section 8 and 9 of the act.
- 5. (1) No person shall do or cause to be done any of the acts prohibited as provided in paragraph 4 hereof in the Conservation Area without first having obtained a permit in the prescribed form.
- 5. (2) Any person given a permit under these By-laws shall comply with the conditions endorsed on the permit together with any directions by the Conservator or an authorised officer or agent of the Authority, from time to time.
- officer of the Authority duly authorised in that behalf may at all reasonable times enter upon any part of the Conservation Area under permit for use by any person for the purpose of inspection and for ensuring compliance with the provisions of these by-laws.
- 7. (1) Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these By-laws or any direction or

conditions given by the Conservator or an authorised officer or agent of the Authority shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to such penalty as may be imposed under the Ordinance.

7.(2) In addition to any penalty which may be imposed under these By-laws, the court trying any case under these By-laws may issue any order which it considers appropriate in the circumstances.
