THE REGULATION OF TRADE ACT, 1980
(No. 18 of 1980)

ORDER

THE: REGULATION OF TRADE (REGISTRATION OF IMPORTERS OF SUGAR ORDER, 2000

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Trade (Registration of importers of Sugar) Order, 2000.
- 2: In this Order unless the context requires otherwise-
"Minister" means the Minister for the time being responsible for trade;
"registered importer" means any person natural or legal specified under the Schedule;
"supplier" means any person, natural or legal who supplies sugar to the registered importer.
- 3.-(1) The Minister, or any Public Officer authorized by him in that behalf, may in writing under his hand, register any persons or body of persons to be importers of sugar.
(2) Where the Minister authorizes a person or body of persons to import sugar in pursuance to paragraph (1) he shall specify in the register the duration of the authority.
(3) No person or body of persons shall import and sell sugar unless that person or body of persons is a registered importer.
(4) Any registered importer, shall immediately after importation of sugar, declare the amount of sugar imported, the value, the unit price, the name and address of the supplier of sugar to the Minister.
5. For the purposes of this Order the registered importers of sugar for domestic and industrial use are specified under the Schedule to this Order.
6. The Government Notice No. 287 of 2000 is hereby revoked.
