The Adulteration of Produce Rules

1. These Rules may be cited as the Adulteration of Produce Rules.

2.—(1) The inspection under the Decree of produce, other than copra in the Zanzibar Copra Market, will ordinarily be carried out between 7.00 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. and between 2.30 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. on all days other than Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, and on a Saturday (not being a public holiday) between 7.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon.

(2) The inspection under the Decree of copra in the Zanzibar Copra Market will ordinarily be carried out between 8.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on all days other than Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, and on a Saturday (not being a public holiday) between 8.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m.:

Provided that a consignment of copra arriving at the Zanzibar Copra Market after 12.00 noon on any weekday (other than Saturday) or 11.00 a.m. on a Saturday will not ordinarily be inspected on the day of its arrival.

(3) An inspector may, on written application to him, undertake or allow to be undertaken the inspection of produce on Sundays or public holidays, or at times other than those specified in paragraphs (1) and (2), on payment of such fees for overtime, calculated in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule in respect of the services of every officer or other person employed in or in connection with the inspection, as shall be notified to the applicant by the inspector.
