THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION (AUTHORIZED OFFICERS) (IDENTITY
CARDS) REGULATIONS, 1974

G.Ns. 1974
Nos. 265
and 270

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation (Authorized Officers) (Identity Cards) Regulations, 1974 and shall come in to operation on the 1st day of December, 1974.
2. Every authorized officer, other than a police officer, and every person appointed by the Director under the provisions of section 2 of the Wildlife Conservation Act, 1974 to exercise the functions of an authorized officer shall carry an identity card in the form prescribed in the Schedule to these Regulations while exercising the functions of an authorized officer.
3. An authorized Officer shall, upon ceasing to be an authorized officer, surrender his identity card to the Director.
4. Any authorized officer who loses his identity card or whose identity card is destroyed or defaced shall as soon as possible, report the loss, destruction or, as the case may be, defacement to the Director who may issue a fresh card.
5. The Director shall maintain a register of all authorized officers in which shall be recorded the name of the officer and the particulars of the identity card issued to him.



1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wildlife Conservation (Compounding of Offences) (Forms) Regulations, 1974 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of December, 1974.

2. Where any offence is compounded pursuant to the provisions of section 82 of the Wildlife Conservation Act, 1974 a document in the form prescribed in the Schedule to these Regulations shall be made out and shall be signed both by the offender and the officer compounding the offence and attested by at least one witness.
