## Fishing (Licence Ownership and Interest) Registration (Fees) Regulations 2012

#### 1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the Fishing (Licence Ownership and Interest) Registration (Fees) Regulations 2012 .

#### 2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 12 June 2012.

### **3. Interpretation**

In these regulations –

*Act* means the Fishing (Licence Ownership and Interest) Registration Act 2001 .

### **4. Fees**

The fees specified in Schedule 1 are prescribed as the fees payable under the Act in respect of the matters to which they respectively relate.
