

**PUBLIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
(POUND FEES AND FORMS) REGULATIONS – SECTION 70**

(Legal Notice 44/1993)

Commencement

[12 November 1993]

Short title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public and Environmental Health (Pound Fees and Forms) Regulations.

Fees for impoundment and sustenance of animals

2. The fees to which a poundkeeper shall be entitled for the purpose of section 25(3) of the Ordinance shall be as follows—

- (a) for the impoundment of every horse, mare, gelding, mule, ass, bull, cow, steer, heifer, calf, sheep, lamb, goat, kid, hog or pig, \$25, and, in addition, for each day or part of a day during which any such animal remains in the pound after the first day, \$5;
- (b) for the sustenance of—
 - (i) every horse, mare, gelding, mule, bull, cow, steer or heifer, \$10 per day;
 - (ii) every ass, calf, sheep, lamb, goat, kid, hog or pig, \$5 per day.

Compensation for straying of animals

3. The compensation to which the occupier of any land shall be entitled for the purpose of section 26(3)(a) of the Ordinance shall be as follows—

- (a) for the first occasion on which the straying occurs, for every horse, mare, gelding, mule, ass, bull, cow, steer, heifer, calf, hog, pig, sheep, lamb, goat, or kid, \$100;
- (b) for the second or subsequent occasion on which the straying occurs, \$200 for each animal referred to in paragraph (a).

Form of notice and certificate of assessment

4. The form and certificate referred to in section 26(4)(a) of the Ordinance are prescribed in the Schedule.

Fees and mileage for poundkeeper's work

5. The fees and mileage to which a poundkeeper shall be entitled for the purpose of section 26(6) are as follows—

- (a) for his work of assessment, \$25; and

(b) mileage at the rate of \$5 per mile when more than one mile from the pound for which he is responsible.
