

**NOTIFICATION OF MINISTRY OF PUBLIC HEALTH
(No. 174) B.E. 2539(1997)
Re Prescription of Food Prohibited to be Imported or Sold**

Whereas it is deemed appropriate to prohibit the importation or sale of food the expiry date or the suitable period of consumption of which has lapsed as stated in the label thereof,

By virtue of Section 5 and Section 6 (8) of the Foods Act B.E. 2522(1979), the Minister of Public Health hereby issues a notification as follows:

The following foods that the expiry date or the suitable period of consumption of which has lapsed as stated in the label shall be food prohibited to be imported or sold:

1. Infant food and food of continuous formula for infant and children.
2. Supplementary food for infant and children.
3. Modified food for infant and modified milk of continuous formula for infant and children.
4. Cultured milk.
5. Cow's milk that has passed pasteurized process, for example, pasteurized fresh milk, recombined pasteurized milk, flavoured pasteurized milk and pasteurized milk products, etc.
6. Food with special objectives.

This Notification shall be enforced on and from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
